TIPS AND TRICKS FOR USING CHATGPT

This ChatGPT tip sheet offers a quick reference to essential commands, shortcuts and methodologies, allowing users ranging from novice to expert to leverage the power of ChatGPT with ease and precision.

Key terms and definitions

- OpenAl: The organization that developed ChatGPT
- **ChatGPT:** Artificial intelligence (AI) chatbot that generates human-like text
- Generative Al: Al that creates new content based on learned patterns
- Al models: Programs that learn from data to make predictions
- Large language models (LLMs): All that processes and generates human-like text
- Prompts: Phrases or instruction (inputs) sent to ChatGPT
- Prompt engineering: Strategy to optimize ChatGPT inputs
- Microsoft Co-Pilot: Al assistant for Microsoft 365

10 common use cases for ChatGPT

- Customer support: Responding to queries
- **Content creation:** Producing creative text
- Language translation: Translating text
- Educational support: Offering interactive lessons
- Virtual assistant: Scheduling and Q&A
- Code writing: Assisting in programming
- **Chatbots:** Interacting with users
- Game design: Building game narratives
- Knowledge base: Answering questions
- Creative writing aid: Supporting writers

Prompt examples

- System instruction: "You are an assistant who speaks like Shakespeare. Provide a response to 'How are you doing today?""
- **Specific context:** "In the context of finance, explain the term 'dividend.""
- Asking for pros and cons: "What are the pros and cons of using solar energy as a renewable resource?"
- Narrowing down: "Limit your response to two sentences: What is the capital of Japan?"
- Role-play interaction: "You are a restaurant critic.
 Write a review of a fictional restaurant called
 'Taste of Heaven."
- **Completing a sentence:** "Finish this sentence: "Innovation is important because..."
- Opinions vs. facts: "What is your opinion on the impact of social media on society? Provide both positive and negative aspects."
- Comparing and contrasting: "Compare and contrast the main characters of 'Harry Potter' and 'Lord of the Rings."
- Request for personal experience: "Share a personal experience where you overcame a challenge in your life."
- Conditional prompt: "If you were planning a trip to Paris, what are the top three places you would visit and why?"

Prompt frameworks

When interacting with ChatGPT, it's crucial to provide a clear and well–structured prompt in generating meaningful and useful responses.

- RTF (role, task, format)
- CTF (context, task, format)
- RASCEF (role, action, steps, context, examples, format)

Two methods for prompting:

- Megaprompts: Write one big message that contains all of the above (i.e., ask for a full press release)
- Prompt chaining: Break down the tasks into smaller steps (i.e., start by asking for a blog post idea, then an outline, then the content)



Tones

ChatGPT can adapt its tone based on the context and prompt it receives.

"Tone: [x]" or "Write using a [x] tone"

- Authoritative: Expresses confidence and knowledge
- **Empathetic:** Shows understanding and compassion
- Creative: Uses imagination in outputs
- **Neutral:** Avoids bias, personal opinions or judgments
- **Persuasive:** Influences opinions or convinces
- **Enthusiastic:** Demonstrates excitement and positivity
- Formal: Uses professional language for official contexts
- **Informative:** Provides factual and detailed information
- Friendly: Has a warm and approachable tone
- **Professional:** Uses a serious tone for formal interactions
- Casual: Uses relaxed and informal language

Responsible use and miscellaneous tips

- Avoid bias: Use diverse, representative training data
- Fact check: Confirm ChatGPT's responses for accuracy
- Disclose Al usage: Inform users they're interacting with Al
- Set expectations: Clarify ChatGPT's capabilities and limitations
- Prevent harmful content: Don't use ChatGPT for harmful or offensive content
- Maintain privacy: Don't share sensitive personal information while interacting
- **Tabular format option:** Ask ChatGPT to output response in a table
- Copy and paste text: Simplify something you don't understand, or summarize
- Output style: Ask ChatGPT to output the response in the style of your favorite author or company

- **Kayak**: Provides travel information
- AskYourPDF: Pulls data out of PDFs
- Link Reader: Searches the web
- Open Table: Makes reservations

- Wolfram: Provides the best answers for math, science and finance
- There's An Al For That: Finds useful Al programs
- What to Watch: Finds streaming shows
